Light and Space

Alyson Shotz's sculptures, which seem to be made of evanescent light effects, are ideally suited to the towering glass-walled **Espace Louis Vuitton Tokyo**. The Brooklyn-based artist is presenting five new works there, but *Geometry of Light*, above, which lends its name to the show, soars above the others. Strung across the space are waves of plastic Fresnel lenses that capture and transform views of the surrounding city as the visitor walks among them. The exhibition, on the Omotesando-district building's seventh floor, above the luxury-goods company's store, runs through December 25. —ERIC BRYANT
